



## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES



**ALL OCCUPANTS TO PUT ON PFDs**  
PFDs must be easily accessible and all persons on board should know how to use them.



**INFORM**  
a person of your trip intentions



**CHECK**  
the marine weather report



**PHONE**  
Call 000



**MAINTAIN**  
a good lookout and operate at a safe speed



**STAY WITH YOUR BOAT**  
A vessel is a lot easier to spot than a swimmer. Anchor your boat to maintain position if safe to do so.

**Exclusive Use & Special Purpose Areas for the Purpose of Clause 13.**

Vessels with engines which are engaged in waterskiing, personal water craft activity or other power boating activities north of this line are allowed only during the following times:

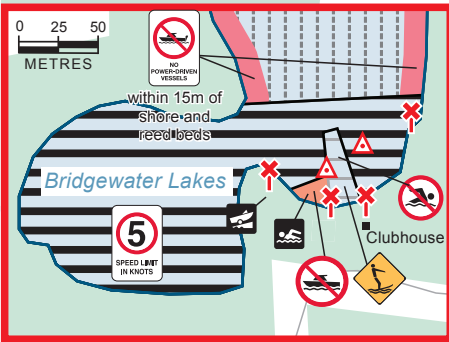
December - February	10am - 8pm summertime
March - May	10am - 6pm EST (11am-7pm summertime)
June - July	10am - 5pm EST
August - November	10am - 6pm EST

Fishing from boats and SCUBA diving may only be undertaken in these waters during those times when power boating activities are not permitted in these waters.

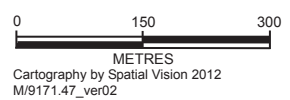
**Exclusive Use & Special Purpose Areas for the Purpose of Clause 13.**

Personal water craft, waterskiing and other power boating activities may commence at 9am south of this line.

A person must not operate a vessel on the waters of Bridgewater Lakes at a speed exceeding 5 knots within 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure in or on the water - except in an access lane
