**ALL OCCUPANTS TO PUT ON PFDs**  
PFDs must be easily accessible and all persons on board should know how to use them.

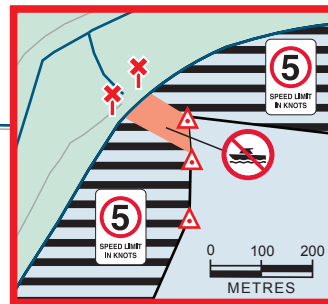
**INFORM**

**CHECK**  
the marine weather report

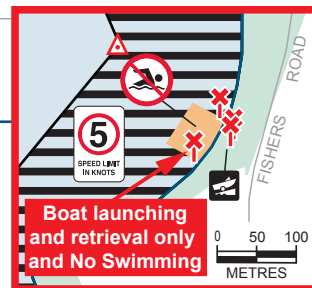
**PHONE**

**MAINTAIN**  
a good lookout and operate at a safe speed

**STAY WITH YOUR BOAT**  
A vessel is a lot easier to spot than a swimmer. Anchor your boat to maintain position if safe to do so.

A person must not operate a vessel on the waters of Taylors Lake (Horsham) at a speed exceeding 5 knots within 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure in or on the water - except in an access lane
