



EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- ALL OCCUPANTS TO PUT ON PFDs**
PFDs must be easily accessible and all persons on board should know how to use them.
- INFORM**
a person of your trip intentions
- CHECK**
the marine weather report
- PHONE**
Call 000
- MAINTAIN**
a good lookout and operate at a safe speed
- STAY WITH YOUR BOAT**
A vessel is a lot easier to spot than a swimmer. Anchor your boat to maintain position if safe to do so.

WATERS - LAKE LINLITHGOW & BULLRUSH SWAMP

Waterway Manager - Southern Grampians Shire Council (Ph: 5573 0444)

- Waters of Lake Linlithgow & Bullrush Swamp
- Waters where vessels are prohibited
- Speed Limit Zone
- No Boating
- Sign / Post / Beacon
- Waters outside those specified in Schedule 36
- Clockwise direction of travel
- Boat Ramp



A person must not operate a vessel on the waters of Lake Linlithgow & Bullrush Swamp at a speed exceeding 5 knots within 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure in or on the water - except in an access lane
